PATTERN NOTES

The cardigan is worked in rows from the bottom up. The yoke is shaped with raglan decreases. The cardigan is worked with a lattice pattern on the sleeves and body, but also looks fine with sleeves in stocking (stockinette) stitch.

LATTICE PATTERN

Row 1 (WS): purl.

Row 2: k2, *sl3pwyif, k1*, repeat from * to * to end of row.

Row 3: purl.

Row 4: k2, *k1, k1 uls, k2*, repeat from * to * to end of row.

Row 5: purl.

Row 6: *sl3pwyif, k1*, repeat from * to * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 7: purl.

Row 8: *k1, k1 uls, k2*; repeat from * to * to last 2 sts, k2.

Repeat rows 1-8.

BODY

On 3mm (UK 11, US 2/3) needles, cast on 136(148:164:184:192:204) sts.

Row 1 (WS): edge st, (k1, p1) to last st, edge st.

Row 2: edge st, (k1, p1) to last st, edge st.

Continue working rows in rib in this way until border measures 2cm (¾in), ending on a RS row.

Next row (WS): edge st, work lattice pattern (as above) to last st, edge st. Continue to work in lattice pattern until work measures approx. 15(16:19:22:23:26)cm / $6(6\frac{1}{4}:7\frac{1}{4}:8\frac{3}{4}:9:10\frac{1}{4})$ in or desired length for body (longer rather than shorter), ending with a row 4 or row 8 of the pattern and taking a note of this to match sleeve cast-(bound-)off.

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Next row (WS): edge st, p26(29:33:38:40:43), cast (bind) off 12 sts, p until there are 58(64:72:82:86:92) sts on the needle after cast-(bound-)off, cast (bind) off 12 sts, p26(29:33:38:40:43), edge st.

112(124:140:160:168:180) sts.

Set the work aside and make the sleeves.

SLEEVES

With 3mm (UK 11, US 2/3) needles cast on 40(44:44:48:52:56) sts and work rib as for body until measures 2cm (¾in), ending on a RS row.

Next row (WS): edge st, work in lattice pattern to last st, edge st.

Continue in pattern with edge sts at each side until work measures 2(2:2:2:2:5:3)cm / ¾(¾:¾:¾:1:1¼)in from ribbed border.

Next row (RS inc): edge st, mil, work lattice pattern to last st, mir, edge st. 2 sts increased.

Increase in this way on RS rows a total of 5(7:9:9:9:9) times with 2(2:2:2:2:5:3)cm / ¾(¾:¾:¾:1:1¼) in between increase rows. Work the new sts in st st and then into the pattern when possible. 50(58:62:66:70:74) sts.

Continue in pattern without shaping until the sleeve measures 16(19:22:26:30:34)cm / 6¼(7½:8¾:10¼:11¾:13½)in from cast-on (bound-on) edge.

SHAPE SLEEVECAP

Cast (bind) off for the armhole on row 1 or row 5 of the pattern as noted on the body, by casting off the first and last 7 sts, including the edge sts. 36(44:48:52:56:60) sts. Set the sleeve aside and make a second sleeve in the same way.

JOIN BODY AND SLEEVES

Next row (RS): edge st, *patt to cast-(bound-)off sts, pm, knit first st of sleeve, pm, patt across sleeve sts to last st, pm, knit last st of sleeve*, rep from * to * once more, patt to last st, edge st. 184(212:236:264:280:300) sts.

Work one WS row, purling sts between markers.

Next row (RS dec): edge st, *patt to 2 sts before marker, skpo, sm, k1, sm, k2tog*, rep from * to * 3 more times, patt to last st, edge st.

Repeat dec row every RS row a total of 8(11:14:17:19:21) times.

120(124:124:128:128:132) sts.

Work 1 WS row.

SHAPE NECK

Next row (RS): cast (bind) off 3(3:3:4:4:4) sts, patt to end, working raglan decreases as set. 109(113:113:116:116:120) sts. Next row: cast (bind) off 3(3:3:4:4:4), patt to end. 106(110:110:112:112:116) sts. Next row: cast (bind) off 2(2:2:3:3) sts, patt to end, working raglan decreases as set. 96(100:100:101:101:105) sts. **Next row:** cast (bind) off 2(2:2:3:3:3) sts, patt to end. 94(98:98:98:98:102) sts. **Next row:** cast (bind) off 2 sts, patt to end, working raglan decreases as set.

84(88:88:88:92) sts.

Next row: cast (bind) off 2 sts, patt to end. 82(86:86:86:86:90) sts.

Next row: cast (bind) off 1(1:1:2: 2:2) sts, patt to end, working raglan decreases as set.

73(77:77:76:76:80) sts. **Next row:** cast (bind) off 1(1:1:2:2:2) sts, patt to end. 72(76:76:74:74:78) sts.

Next row: cast (bind) off 1 st, patt to end, working raglan decreases as set. 63(67:67:65:65:69) sts.

Next row: cast (bind) off 1 st, patt to end. 62(66:66:64:64:68) sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail.
