# Tree Skirt 

The bases of Christmas trees are never the prettiest, so this simple tree skirt is the ideal solution to disguise stands and pots.

## What you need

A triangle from card to use as a template, measuring $12 \mathrm{in}(30.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ tall and $41 / 2 \mathrm{in}$ $(11.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ across the bottom. You will use this to cut sixteen triangles of fabric: I used three designs of fabric but you could choose two patterns, or keep it plain with one fabric
A circle of lining fabric measuring 24in ( 61 cm ) across. If you don't have a piece of fabric this large you could cut another sixteen triangles of lining fabric and create the shape following steps 6 and 7

A circle of wadding (batting) measuring 24in ( 61 cm ) across
$23 / 4$ yards $(254 \mathrm{~cm})$ of 1in ( 2.5 cm ) bias tape - you will have a little left over

Repositionable spray adhesive

Three elastic hair bungees for the button loops
Three buttons
Red felt
Green felt
Hot-glue gun
Dark red and dark green marker pens
Nine beads, one for the centre of each flower
