

Revisions for 'Knitted Pirates, Princesses, Witches, Wizards and Fairies'

Witch's hat, page 28

row 45: (K7, K2tog) 4 times, K5, K2tog [38 sts].

Satchel, page 35

rows 39–58: repeat blocks A and B alternately for 5 blocks, commencing with block A.

row 59: cast off 4 sts, K4, P4, K8 [16 sts].

row 60: cast off 4 sts, P4, K4, P4 [12 sts].

row 61: K4, P4, K4.

row 62: P4, K4, P4.

row 63: cast off 4 sts, K8 [8 sts].

row 64: cast off 4 sts, P4 [4 sts].

row 65: K4.

row 66: P4.

row 67: cast off 4 sts.

Tricorn hat, page 65

Start knitting the hat at the brim.

Using 3.00mm (US 3) needles and dark blue yarn, cast on 160 sts.

row 1: knit.

row 2: (P8, P2tog) to end [144 sts].

row 3: knit.

row 4: (P8, P2tog) to last 4 sts, P4 [130 sts].

row 5: knit.

row 6: (P8, P2tog) to end [117 sts].

row 7: knit.

row 8: (P8, P2tog) to last 7 sts, P7 [106 sts].

row 9: knit.

row 10: (P8, P2tog) to last 6 sts, P6 [96 sts].

row 11: knit.

row 12: (P8, P2tog) to last 6 sts, P6 [87 sts].

row 13: knit.

row 14: (P8, P2tog) to last 7 sts, P7 [79 sts].

row 15: knit.

row 16: (P8, P2tog) to last 9 sts, P9 [72 sts].

rows 17–27: SS, commencing with a knit row.

row 28: purl.

row 29: K5, (K2tog, K10) 5 times, K2tog, K5 [66 sts].

row 30: purl.

row 31: K5, (K2tog, K9) 5 times, K2tog, K4 [60 sts].

row 32: purl.

row 33: K4, (K2tog, K8) 5 times, K2tog, K4 [54 sts].

row 34: purl.

row 35: K4, (K2tog, K7) 5 times, K2tog, K3 [48 sts].

row 36: purl.

row 37: K3, (K2tog, K6) 5 times, K2tog, K3 [42 sts].

row 38: purl.

row 39: K3, (K2tog, K5) 5 times, K2tog, K2 [36 sts].

row 40: purl.

row 41: K2, (K2tog, K4) 5 times, K2tog, K2 [30 sts].

row 42: purl.

row 43: K2, (K2tog, K3) 5 times, K2tog, K1 [24 sts].

row 44: purl.

row 45: K1, (K2tog, K2) 5 times, K2tog, K1 [18 sts].

row 46: (P2tog) 9 times [9 sts].

Break yarn, leaving a 30cm (11¾in) tail. Thread the yarn through the remaining 9 sts and finish off tightly. Continue to sew the edges of the hat together down to the beginning of the brim. Using the cast-on waste yarn, sew the brim. As it is turned up to form the three corners of the hat, make the underside the RS.

Wizard's hair, page 73

row 29: K16, sl1, turn, ytb, K14, sl1, turn, ytb, K12, sl1, turn, ytb, sl1, LS10, sl1, turn, ytb, sl1, knit to end.

Wizard's hat, page 73

row 5: K5, K2tog, (K10, K2tog) 4 times, K5 [55 sts].
row 11: K5, K2tog, (K9, K2tog) 4 times, K4 [50 sts].
row 17: K4, K2tog, (K8, K2tog) 4 times, K4 [45 sts].
row 23: K4, K2tog, (K7, K2tog) 4 times, K3 [40 sts].
row 29: K3, K2tog, (K6, K2tog) 4 times, K3 [35 sts].
row 35: K3, K2tog, (K5, K2tog) 4 times, K2 [30 sts].
row 41: K2, K2tog, (K4, K2tog) 4 times, K2 [25 sts].
row 47: K2, K2tog, (K3, K2tog) 4 times, K1 [20 sts].
row 53: K1, K2tog, (K2, K2tog) 4 times, K1 [15 sts].

Cloak: shaping the waistline, page 79

row 111: (K4, K2tog) 4 times, K3, K2tog, K2, K2tog tbl, K3, (K2tog tbl, K4) 4 times [50 sts].

Cloak: sleeves, page 80

SS for 36 rows, decreasing 1 st at each end of the sixth and every following sixth row until 48 sts remain.

Sandals, page 81

Use 2.25mm (US 1) needles.

Pants, page 101

First leg

row 1: with RS facing, pick up 35 sts along the straight edge of the lace edging.

row 2: purl.

row 3: (K2, yfwd) to last st, K1 [52 sts].

rows 4–34: SS, commencing with a purl row.

Break yarn and put sts on to a stitch holder.

Second leg

Repeat rows 1–34 (first leg).

row 35: knit across the 52 sts of second leg then put held sts of first leg on to needle and knit across [104 sts].

row 36: purl.

rows 37–52: SS, commencing with a knit row.

row 53: K2, (K2tog) to last st, K2 [54 sts].

Change to 2.25mm (US 1) needles.

row 54: rib (K1, P1) to end.

row 55: repeat row 54.

row 56: K1, (yfwd, K2tog) to last st, yfwd, K1 [55 sts].

row 57: rib (K1, P1) to last st, K1.

row 58: cast off ribwise.
