

## Head

With a 3.5mm hook and CC, make a magic circle.

**Rnd 1:** working into the magic circle, 6 dc (6 sts).

**Rnd 2:** [2 dc in next stitch] six times (12 sts).

**Rnd 3:** [3 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] three times (15 sts).

**Rnd 4:** [4 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] three times (18 sts).

**Rnd 5:** [5 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] three times (21 sts).

**Rnd 6:** dc around (21 sts).

**Rnd 7:** [6 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] three times.

Change to MC on last yo of round (24 sts).

**Rnd 8:** place a stitch marker after the first 3 dc to mark the top centre of the head [3 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] six times (30 sts).

**Rnd 9:** [4 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] six times (36 sts).

**Rnd 10:** [5 dc, 2 dc in next stitch] six times (42 sts).

**Rnds 11-17:** dc around (42 sts).

**Rnd 18:** [5 dc, 1 dc2tog] six times (36 sts).

**Rnd 19:** [4 dc, 1 dc2tog] six times (30 sts).

Start to stuff, and top up as you go.

**Rnd 20:** [3 dc, 1 dc2tog] six times (24 sts).

**Rnd 21:** [2 dc, 1 dc2tog] six times (18 sts).

**Rnd 22:** [1 dc, 1 dc2tog] six times (12 sts).

**Rnd 23:** [1 dc2tog] six times (6 sts).

Fasten off and close the remaining hole with slip stitch.
