

WRITTEN PATTERN EXAMPLES

If you are more familiar reading words than charts, try reading these written patterns while referring to cards 10 and 33, so that you can see how the two correspond and build up your confidence.

10. V-STITCH

To work the stitch pattern any size

Starting chain:
multiple of 3 + 7.

Rep Row 2 until
you reach the
desired size.

To work the square shown on card no. 10

Make 19 ch.

Row 1: (1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc) in fifth ch from hook, (missed ch count as 1 dc, 1 ch) * miss next 2 ch, (1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc) in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, miss next ch, 1 dc in last ch, turn (12 dc).

Row 2: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc), * (1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc) in next 1 ch sp; rep from * to last st, 1 dc in last st, turn (12 dc).

Rep Row 2 for pattern, working in 1-row stripes of Yarns A–C until the fabric is square.
