

What you need

From the outer fabric:

For the back of the bag, a piece measuring 10 x 8in (25.5 x 20.5cm)

For the front of the bag, a strip of fabric measuring 10 x 1½in (25.5 x 4cm)

For the front of the bag, a strip of fabric measuring 10 x 2in (25.5 x 5cm)

For the front of the bag, a rectangle measuring 10 x 6in (25.5 x 15.25cm)

For the front of the bag, five strips measuring 1½ x 6in (4 x 15.25cm)

For the lining, two pieces of contrasting fabric measuring 10 x 8in (25.5 x 20.5cm) each
10in (25.5cm) nylon zip

Five strips of contrasting fabric cut on the bias, measuring 6 x 4in (15.25 x 10cm)

20in (51cm) lace

13in (33cm) ribbon

Two buttons

Rotary cutter, gridded ruler and mat to cut the bias strips

Repositionable adhesive



1 First cut your bias strips using the 45-degree angle on your gridded ruler.



2 Fold the long edges into the centre, square off the ends and press.



3 Place each folded piece on your table with the raw edges to the back. Lay each of the five outer strips centrally on top – spray with a little repositionable adhesive to secure.
