

# Twister Scarf



## Materials:

» 1 x 100g hank of DK yarn –  
variegated, 270m (295yd)

## Needles:

» 1 pair of 4mm (UK 8; US 6) single-pointed  
knitting needles  
» Large-eyed tapestry needle

## Instructions:

### Initial rows

Rows 1–2: Using 4mm (UK 8; US 6) needles, cast on 20 sts in variegated yarn, ktbl on return row (i.e. row 2).

### Scarf pattern

Row 1: k8, turn, k8.

Row 2: k6, turn, k6.

Row 3: k4, turn, k4.

Row 4: Knit across 20 sts on needle.

Repeat rows 1–4 until approximately 1m (39in) of the yarn is left.

Cast off the 20 sts, then use the large-eyed embroidery needle to sew in the ends of the yarn.

This is a really simple scarf that has a twist created by knitting different numbers of stitches into the rows. I have chosen a lovely variegated merino and silk yarn in a summery colours but it could equally be knitted in another soft yarn.
