



# PUPPY

## Instructions

### Body

Using brown yarn, follow the instructions on page 28 for the Bunny.

### Tummy

Using cream yarn and 3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) knitting needles, cast on 5 sts and purl 1 row.

**Next row:** K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 sts).

**Next row:** P1, M1, P5, M1, P1 (9 sts).

**Next row:** K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 sts).

Starting with a purl row work 3 rows in SS.

**Next row:** K1, ssK, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1 (9 sts).

Purl 1 row.

Repeat last two rows once more (7 sts).

Starting with a knit row, work 2 rows in SS.

**Next row:** K1, ssK, K1, K2tog, K1 (5 sts).

Starting with a purl row, work 3 rows in SS.

**Next row:** ssK, K1, K2tog (3 sts).

**Next row (WS):** Cast off.

### Head

Using cream yarn and 3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) knitting needles, cast on 5 sts.

**Next row:** (K1, M1) four times, K1 (9 sts).

Purl 1 row.

**Next row:** (K1, M1) eight times, K1 (17 sts).

Starting with a purl row, work 3 rows in SS.

Change to brown yarn and cont in SS.

**Next row:** K5, ssK, K3, K2tog, K5 (15 sts).

Purl 1 row.

**Next row:** K1, M1, K5, M1, K3, M1, K5, M1, K1 (19 sts).

**Next row:** P8, M1, P3, M1, P8 (21 sts).

**Next row:** K9, M1, K3, M1, K9 (23 sts).

**Next row:** P10, M1, P3, M1, P10 (25 sts).

**Next row:** K11, M1, K3, M1, K11 (27 sts).

**Next row:** P12, M1, P3, M1, P12 (29 sts).

**Next row:** K13, M1, K3, M1, K13 (31 sts).

Starting with a purl row, work 5 rows in SS.

**Next row:** K12, ssK, K3, K2tog, K12 (29 sts).

**Next row:** P1, P2tog, P23, P2togtbl, P1 (27 sts).

**Next row:** K1, ssK, K7, K2tog, K3, ssK, K7, K2tog, K1 (23 sts).

Purl 1 row.

## MATERIALS

55m (60yd) tweed aran (10-ply/worsted) yarn in brown

15m (16.5yd) tweed aran (10-ply/worsted) yarn in cream

Small amount of 4-ply (fingering) yarn in black

Toy stuffing

Two 6mm beads

Black sewing thread

## TOOLS

Two 3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) knitting needles and a spare needle for three-needle cast-off

2.75mm (UK 12, US 2) knitting needles

Sewing needle

**Next row:** K1, ssK, K5, K2tog, K3, ssK, K5, K2tog, K1 (19 sts).

**Next row:** P1, P2tog, P3, P2togtbl, P3, P2tog, P3, P2togtbl, P1 (15 sts).

**Next row:** K7, K2tog, K6 (14 sts).

Divide the remaining stitches over two needles and cast off using the three-needle cast-off technique (see page 18).

### Leg (make two)

Using brown yarn, follow instructions on page 28 for the Bunny, changing to cream yarn after the first 12 SS rows.

### Arm (make two)

Using brown yarn, follow instructions on page 28 for the Bunny, changing to cream yarn after the first 10 rows in SS.

### Ear (make two)

Using brown yarn and 3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) knitting needles, cast on 5 sts and, starting with a knit row, work 2 rows in SS.

**Next row:** K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 sts).

Starting with a purl row work 11 rows in SS.

**Next row:** ssK, K3, K2tog (5 sts).

**Next row:** P2tog, P1, P2togtbl (3 sts).

Cast off.

### Ear lining (make two)

Using cream yarn and 3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) knitting needles, cast on 4 sts and purl 1 row.

**Next row:** K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 sts).

Starting with a purl row, work 11 rows in SS.

**Next row:** ssK, K2, K2tog (4 sts).

**Next row:** P2tog, P2togtbl (2 sts).

Pass one stitch over the other to cast off.



# DRESSING GOWN

## MATERIALS

- ② 95m (104yd) of 4-ply (fingering) yarn in pink
- ② Embroidery thread in pink, yellow and green

## TOOLS

- ② 3mm (UK 11, US 2/3) knitting needles
- ② Sewing needle

## TENSION (GAUGE)

- ② 7 sts = 2.5cm (1in) in SS on 3mm (UK 11, US 2/3) knitting needles

## Top Tip!

When working in moss stitch (MS), place a marker on the RS of the work as a reminder. You will need to know so that when you work the collar pieces they are in the right place.

## Instructions

### Note:

This is worked in MS throughout. To work MS over an even number of sts:

**Row 1:** K1, P1 to end of row.

**Row 2:** P1, K1 to end of row.

Therefore you work a purl stitch over a knit stitch and a knit stitch over a purl stitch.



## Back

Cast on 36 sts and work in MS until work measures 3cm (1¼in).

**Next row:** K2tog, work to last 2 sts, K2tog (34 sts).

Continue in MS and repeat this decrease row when work measures 5cm (2in), 7cm (2¾in) and 8cm (3⅛in) (28 sts).

Continue in MS and when work measures 9cm (3½in), cast off 2 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows (24 sts).

**Next row:** K2tog, work to last 2 sts, K2tog (22 sts).

Repeat last row once more (20 sts).

Continue in MS until armhole measures 5cm (2in).

Cast off.

## Front (make two)

Cast on 18 sts and work in MS until work measures 3cm (1¼in).

**Next row:** K2tog, **work** to end of row (17 sts).

Continue in MS and repeat this decrease row when work measures 5cm (2in), 7cm (2¾in) and 8cm (3⅛in) (14 sts).

Continue in MS and when work measures 9cm (3½in), work as follows:

**Next row:** Cast off 2 sts at the beginning of the row, **work** to last st, M1, K1 (13 sts).

**Next row:** Work to last 2 sts, K2tog (12 sts).

**Next row:** K2tog, work to end of row (11 sts).

Continue in MS until armhole measures 5cm (2in), ending at armhole edge.
