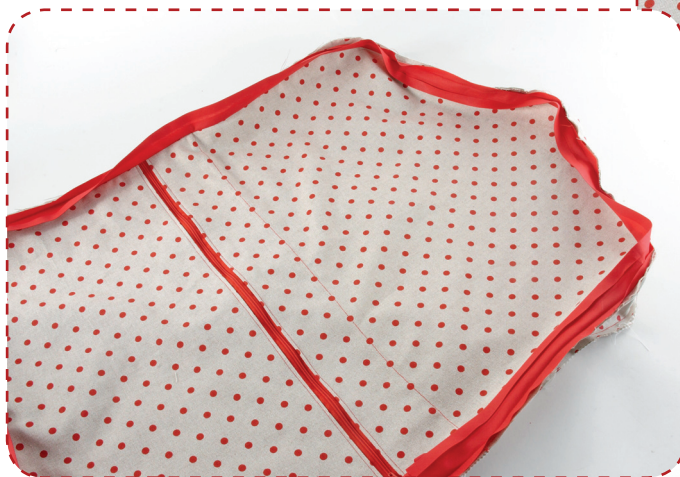


8 Cut along this line, then use this piece as a template to cut the other half, then the other side of the garment cover; **trim the front of the cover to the same width as the back piece.**

9 To attach the gusset, fold over one short end of the fabric twice to make a hem. Start to pin, wrong sides together, to the top of the front of the cover, 2.5cm (1in) from the top centre point. When you reach the other end, fold over twice again. You may need to trim the fabric here as I have been generous with the measurements – better too long than too short! Sew all the way round.



10 Pin the other side of the gusset to the back of the bag, wrong sides together, and sew around. Apply bias binding (see page 10) to both sides of the bag. On this occasion, I would use a sewing machine instead of hand stitching, as there is so much bias binding to sew!

Tip

You could add a couple of zipped pockets to the front, too.
