

# Cardigan



# You will need

#### **YARN**

 $2(2:3:3) \times 50 \text{g}/1^{3}/4 \text{oz}$  balls of Rowan *Pure Wool DK* in Cloud 058

#### **NEEDLES**

Pair each of 3.5mm (US 4) and 4mm (US 6) knitting needles

#### **EXTRAS**

Buttons: 4(5:5:6)

#### **TENSION**

22 sts and 44 rows to 10cm/4in square over garter st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

See page 124.

#### **NOTE**

Pattern is worked in garter st throughout.

#### **SIZES**

Up to 3(3-6:6-9:9-12) months

#### **BACK**

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 42(46:50:56) sts. Work straight in garter st until back measures 11(13:15:17)cm/ $4^{1}/_{4}(5:6:6^{3}/_{4})$ in.

Dec 1 st at each end of next row. Work straight in garter st until back measures 20(23:26:29)cm/8(9:10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>)in. Cast off.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 23(25:27:30) sts. Work straight in garter st until front measures 11(13:15:17)cm/ $4^{1/4}(5:6:6^{3/4})$ in, ending with a WS row.

**Next row** Dec 1 st at armhole edge.

Next row \*(front edge) K2, K2tog tbl,

K to end\*.

Work 3 rows.

**Next row** Rep from \* to \*.

Rep the last 4 rows until there are 15(16:17:19) sts.

Work straight until front measures 20(23:26:29)cm/8(9:10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>)in.

Cast off.

#### LEFT FRONT

Work as for Right front, reversing shaping and making a buttonhole at the front edge as foll:

[K2, K2tog, yf, K] to end. Make the first buttonhole 2cm/³/4in from the bottom edge and then 2(3:3:4) more every 11 rows up to the neck shaping, at this point substitute K2tog tbl for K2tog.

# **SLEEVES** (make 2)

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 28(30:32:34) sts. Inc 1 st at each end on every 10th row until there are 34(38:42:46) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 12(15:18:21)cm/ $4\sqrt[3]{4}(6:7:8\sqrt[4]{in}$ .

Cast off.

#### **POCKET**

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 14(14:16:16) sts.
Work 14(14:16:16) rows in st st.
Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Block and press work.

Join shoulder seams

Fold sleeves in half and place fold on the


shoulder seam.

Sew sleeve in place.

Join the side and the sleeve seam.


Sew pocket into place with a button to secure top.

Sew buttons to correspond with the buttonholes.
